Cooking for the future is a KA3 transnational project co-funded by the Erasmus+ programme of the European Union.

CORE – Cooking for the future project develops cooperation between VET schools and working life in European countries in the Restaurant and Catering sector to promote employment and professional skills and competences.

The aim is to find a European balance for joint cook's qualifications and at the same time to make improvements. Project focuses on developing the existing cook's qualifications by identifying future cook's competence needs in partner countries, improving cook's qualification and creating a new joint cook's international training module.

Skills and competences more visible

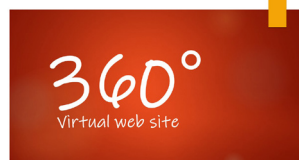


The learning outcomes will be made as transparent as possible by using open educational resources (e.g. Open Badges) for achieving and showcasing the competences needed in the profession.
